





Up until last year, I was a Midsumma virgin and quite cynical about the 'Gay and Lesbian community' outside of dance parties.

But it was somewhere between Federation square and the Botanical Gardens that something changed and all of a sudden I remember not feeling as marginalised anymore, maybe it was the excessive consumption of cheap champagne, or the group discussions about the colour of some woman's bra, but my cynicism shifted. I didn't expect this to happen, but now I kinda feel sorry for non-marginalised friends who don't have parades.





And it may be for more years than we care to imagine, that the 'you bomb my back and I'll bomb yours' is the topic of every party around the globe.

I'm hoping that, because we are people of our times we are well equipped for our times. And so the celebration of a Queer New World, for me, is no longer simply about gender and sexual preference. The Queer New World is exuberant about the co-existence of diversity throughout the whole community. And the Queer that's being asked for is deep, embracing, inclusive, intellectually and spiritually rigorous. Standing solid for collaboration and mutual understanding. The standards of 'us' and 'them' are over if we really believe that Queer has anything to offer the worlds we live in. From now on, it's love. And love with a ferocious tenderness that might surprise even ourselves!





Noel Tovey in... Little Black Bastard

This is the story of Noel Tovey's extraordinary life.

From a childhood punctuated by homelessness, alcoholism, violence and abuse, and after being sent to Pentridge for buggery when he was 17, Noel fled Australia to England and America, where he became a dancer, actor, singer, choreographer and director, working alongside some of the great film and theatre artists of the day. Little Black Bastard tells of the despair encountered as part of his upbringing in Australia in the early part of the twentieth century, to the triumphs achieved in a new life, in a new world.

In Little Black Bastard, Noel recounts his return to Australia and his reconciliation with the country that he could never previously call home.
