Site, Signage & Production Volunteers Brief Sheet – Bump In and Bump Out

General Items – Bump In

- Bump in phase runs from 6am to 11am.
- Role includes:
 - Escorting vehicles on to site, including suppliers and food vendors must drive with hazard lights on, no more than 5km/h.
 - Putting up signage and scrim, making sure the site looks perfect for opening.
 - Site Managers are responsible for setting up their areas, and will assign tasks to their teams to prepare the event.
 - Working closely with the Production Manager and Site Managers behind the scenes.

General Items – Bump Out

- Aid food vendors and suppliers to pack up and exit.
- Packing down the whole event, including signage, scrim and more.

This Role Suits

- This is a fast-paced roving and varied role that requires a lot of standing and walking for longer period of times.
- Bending and some lifting will also be required.
- Any previous production or bump in/out experience is welcomed.
- Most of this happens before or after the big crowds have left.

On Arrival

- Go to Volunteer Headquarters at St Kilda Sports Club next to Ian Johnson Oval to sign on, and collect your accreditation and meal ticket.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator or Volunteer Team Leaders at Volunteer HQ, who will brief you on your role.
- If scheduled on for a bump out shift at <u>Catani</u>, please sign at the Volunteer Tent at Catani Gardens on arrival.

Sensitivity

- Many people who attend, volunteer or perform at Pride March represent diverse communities which may be at risk or prone to discrimination. Keep watch for antisocial crowd members and call for assistance through the EOC or security if required.
- Use gender-neutral pronouns until the person identifies their pronouns.

At the End of your Shift

- Please head to the Volunteer Tent at Catani Gardens and sign out.
- You are then free to enjoy the Post Pride Celebrations Event. Please change out of your volunteer t-shirt and accreditation at this time.
