- The Information Tent may receive Lost and Found Persons. Please refer to Lost Person register on the day.
- Anything you don't know can be referred to Team Leader Alan Drummond.

- Someone who enjoys one-on-one interactions and customer service.
- Organisational skills are valuable as well as FOH and retail experience.
- Seating available.

On Arrival

- Go to Volunteer HQ at LCI to sign on and collect your accreditation.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator at Volunteer HQ or Team Leader, who will brief you on your role.
