Where are the TOILETS?	See the map - each block has accessible toilets. Public toilets are located at: Young St (south of Gertrude) Napier St (north of Gertrude) George St (south of Gertrude) Gore St (either side of Gertrude St) Little Oxford St near Peel St Oxford St (south of Peel St) Peel St and Smith St (permanent toilet).
What's happening on STAGE?	Details displayed in the App, under STAGES online and at the Info Tent
Where is the STALL for ...	Refer to the list of stall holders in the App, at the Info Tent and online under STALL LOCATIONS
How can I contact ACCESS CHAMPIONS?	Phone 0419 682 064. More details under ACCESSIBILITY online.
How can I contact AUDIO DESCRIBERS/TOUCH TOURS?	Travelling Tour between noon and 2pm (pre-bookings needed). Audio Guiders available on request between 3pm and 7pm: contact Nilgun Guven (she/her) at Vitae Veritas on 0400 901 848
Where is the BAR?	Midsumma isn't operating a bar at this event, but lots of local traders will be able to quench your thirst!
Can we drink alcohol on the street?	Generally no, other than at licenced venue outdoor spaces. NO GLASS!
When does the march start?	This is not Midsumma Pride March - it's a street party, not a parade. See online event , especially FAQs.
Where do I REGISTER?	All volunteer sign-ins (+security and cleaners) are at 90 Brunswick St, Fitzroy, near Atherton Gardens. Artist sign-ins are at the relevant stage
Where's the SITE OFFICE?	63 Little Oxford St, Collingwood: off Peel Street Park
Where are the best DROPOFF/ PICKUP points?	Accessible Drop Off on Smith St near Charles St Rideshare dropoff at Oxford St Reserve (dropoff at Derby St x Oxford St or Langridge St x Oxford St) Alternative dropoff location: Brunswick St (between Gertrude St & Palmer St)
Where can I CHARGE my device?	Wheelchairs at the Info Tent Phones: no official charging locations
Where can I get FIRST AID?	Three First Aid locations: Gertrude St between Napier & Brunswick St (near Young St) Gore St & Gertrude St Peel St & Smith St
HELP! Police / Ambulance are needed urgently.	Find a crew member or security guard with a radio and get them to report the situation. There will always be somebody with a radio at stages, at the information tent as well as with roving security around the site. If you can't find a radio bearer, phone 000 but be sure to also report it to EOC (our Emergency Operations Centre) by radio or on 0484 264 864.
Where is the nearest ATM?	Commonwealth: 146 Smith St Westpac: 215 Smith St Convenience Store at 76 Smith St
Where can I get drinking WATER?	Free drinking water at: Napier & Gertrude St Gore & Gertrude St Smith & Langridge St Peel & Lt Oxford St
Where can I get FOOD	From Food Vendors and businesses all around the precinct (see Stalls list on Vicky P event)
There's a danger somewhere (e.g. broken glass)	Contact anyone with a radio, or Security, who will pass on the details
Repairs are needed to ...	Ask anyone with a radio to report the problem
I believe we need to evacuate the precinct - what should I do and where should I go?	In an emergency, instructions will be relayed via the hierarchy: EOC Wardens and Staff Volunteers . Listen for, and follow, special announcements from people with radios or the stages. If instructed, go quickly but calmly to the closest exit. Official emergency assembly points are Atherton Gardens (Cnr Gertrude & Brunswick St) or Oxford St x Peel St.
