

## Volunteer Tent Brief Sheet

### General Brief – St Kilda Sports Club OR Catani Gardens

- On arrival all volunteers will be signing in and out at the Volunteers Tent at either The St Kilda Sports Club at Ian Johnson Oval OR Catani Gardens.
- The role includes signing volunteers in and out of Deputy, supplying them with a volunteer t-shirt, lanyard, water bottle, bag, radio, and radio accessory (if required) and a meal ticket.
- Keep the Volunteer Tent clean and tidy.
- Monitor stock levels of water for volunteers.
- Ensuring cheery customer service and demonstration of Midsumma's core values.

### This Role Suits

- Someone who likes one-on-one interactions rather than big crowds.
- Seating available.
- Organisational skills are valuable.

### On Arrival

- **SHIFT AT CATANI GARDENS** - Go to Volunteer Headquarters at Volunteer Tent at **Catani Gardens** to sign in, and collect your accreditation and meal ticket.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator or Volunteer Team Leaders who will brief you on your role.
- **SHIFT AT IAN JOHNSON OVAL** – Go to Volunteer Headquarters at **St Kilda Sports Club** next to **Ian Johnson Oval** to sign in, and collect your accreditation and meal ticket.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator or Volunteer Team Leaders who will brief you on your role.

### Sensitivity

- Many people who attend, volunteer or perform at Pride March represent diverse communities which may be at risk or prone to discrimination. Keep watch for anti-social crowd members and call for assistance through the EOC or security if required.
- Use gender-neutral pronouns until the person identifies their pronouns.

### At the End of your Shift

- Please head to the Volunteer Tent at **Catani Gardens** and sign out.
- You are then free to enjoy the Post Pride Celebrations Event. Please change out of your volunteer t-shirt and accreditation at this time.
