About Midsumma

Midsumma is Australia's premier queer arts and cultural organisation, bringing together a diverse mix of LGBTQIA+ artists, performers, communities and audiences year-round.

In 2024, Midsumma Festival will expand over 22-days of summer, with a rainbow of queer events that highlight emerging and mainstream LGBTQIA+ arts and culture. Midsumma Festival's program invites you to immerse yourself in the artistic expression of lived experience around gender and sexuality, queer history, and the celebration of new ideas that come to life through world-class art and performance.

Our festival program is made up of diverse art forms and genres, including visual arts, live music, theatre, spoken word, cabaret, film, parties, sport, social events, and public forums.
