

Pridefinder Podcast Assistant - Brief Sheet

General Brief

- The Pridefinder is a travelling studio podcast that has been on a tour around Victoria, collecting stories about the experiences of LGBTQIA+ people living rurally.
- The studio will be set up at Victoria's Pride with Helene, the host, interviewing anyone wanting to share their story on the podcast. The stories collected from regional Victoria will also be available for people to listen to through headphones.
- The role includes chatting to people about the project, assisting audience members with using the headphones, and troubleshooting audio issues with assistance from Helene.
- Ensuring cheery customer service and demonstration of Midsumma's core values.

This Role Suits

- Someone who likes one-on-one interactions rather than big crowds.
- Someone with an interest or skills in podcasting and audio (desirable).
- Seating available if required.

On Arrival

- Go to Volunteer Headquarters at LCI sign in and collect your accreditation.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator at LCI, who will brief you on your role.

Sensitivity

- Many people who attend, volunteer, or perform at Victoria's Pride represent diverse communities which may be at risk or prone to discrimination. Keep watch for anti-social crowd members and call for assistance through the EOC or security if required.
- Use gender-neutral pronouns until the person identifies their pronouns.

- You are then free to enjoy the festival. Please change out of your volunteer t-shirt and accreditation at this time.
