Fly Squad - Brief Sheet

General Brief

- Main tasks for the Fly Squad is to be roving and help out where required.
- Fast and full of fun, 'flying' to assist with areas that require the most attention at the time.
- This could include jumping into various volunteer roles or being asked to complete a task by either the Volunteer Coordinator, Head of Production, Site Managers or other Midsumma staff.
- An example could be being asked to secure some signage that has fallen down, and once completed head to the Information Tent to cover breaks and thereafter head over to help the stalls bump out.

This Role Suits

- Anyone who wants to experience lots of different roles and is okay with jumping in where required.
- Enjoys a fast-paced environment.
- May require some bending, lifting, standing for longer periods of time and/or walking on uneven surfaces.
- Can require one-on-one interactions as well as being surrounded by crowds.

On Arrival

- Go to the Volunteer Headquarters to sign in, and collect your accreditation.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator at Volunteer Tent, who will brief you on your role.

Sensitivity

- Many people who attend, volunteer or perform at Victoria's Pride represent diverse communities which may be at risk or prone to discrimination. Keep watch for anti-social crowd members and call for assistance through your Manager, EOC or Security if required.
- Use gender-neutral pronouns until the person identifies their pronouns.

At the End of your Shift

- Please come back to the Volunteer Tent and sign out.
- You are then free to enjoy the festival. Please change out of your volunteer t-shirt and accreditation at this time.
