### **About Midsumma**

Based in Victoria, Midsumma Festival is Australia's premier LGBTQIA+ cultural organisation, fostering communities connected by Diverse Gender and Sexuality (DGS) experiences. We celebrate and promote LGBTQIA+ arts and culture, providing platforms for connection and belonging. Our strategic focus includes intersectional communities, such as First Nations, deaf, disabled, neurodiverse, culturally and linguistically diverse, diverse families, and seniors. Midsumma works year-round to support artists and culture-makers, culminating in our annual three-week festival, featuring over 220 events across Melbourne and Victoria, engaging an audience of over 300,000.

## **Job Summary**

The Volunteer's Coordinator is responsible for managing all aspects of Midsumma Festival's Volunteers Program. This includes volunteer recruitment, onboarding, communication, scheduling, and on-site coordination during key events. The role collaborates closely with the Head of Production & Operations, Program Manager, and Marketing Manager to ensure volunteers are effectively engaged across the festival. Up to 500 volunteers support a range of activities and the coordinator plays a hands-on role during peak delivery periods.

### **Key Accountabilities**

#### **Volunteer Coordination**

- Coordinate the recruitment, selection, onboarding, and training of volunteers
- Maintain an up-to-date database of volunteer details and assignments
- Deliver induction and briefing processes, including handbooks and role descriptions
- Host volunteer briefings and social events, including the closing party
- Create and manage volunteer rosters to ensure coverage at all festival events
- Supervise and support volunteers during events, including bump in/out where needed
- Monitor volunteer satisfaction, performance, and engagement
- Recognise volunteer contributions through tailored support and recognition initiatives

- Collaborate with the Marketing Manager on volunteer engagement in fundraising initiatives
- Develop and maintain effective administrative systems and procedures
- Actively contribute to a positive and inclusive team environment

#### Other Duties

- Attend team meetings and contribute to Midsumma's positive team culture.
- Support across all Midsumma events and activities as needed.
- Comply with all internal policies and procedures.
