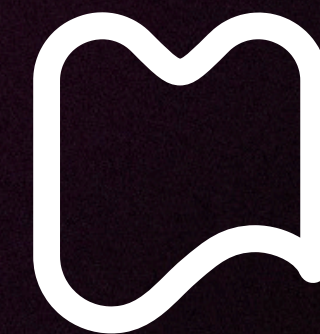

Midsumma is a year-round cultural organisation dedicated to supporting, developing, and elevating LGBTQIA+ artists and communities.

Midsumma creates a “queer” ecosystem as a micro labour market, through year-round mentorship, professional development programs, and inclusive creative pathways, including dedicated support for emerging artists and artists with disability. Midsumma invests in the long-term strength, visibility, and well-being of the community.

This ongoing work culminates each summer in the three-week Midsumma Festival, one of Australia’s most visible and impactful cultural celebrations, bringing these voices, stories, and creative outcomes to life at scale.

Together with YOU, alongside our communities, we have the opportunity to go further, not just celebrating how far we have come over Midsumma’s 40 years, but actively supporting our rich future, more inclusive outcomes, and keeping our stories and lived experiences thriving.

If we build this together, we can create something that extends beyond the festival moment, into everyday impact.

# delivering real impact

Midsumma is more than a festival; it is a year-round platform that supports the health, well-being, and connection of diverse communities across Australia.

In 2026, Midsumma Festival reached **334,531 attendees**, the largest audience in the festival's history, reflecting both scale and sustained cultural relevance.

But what matters most is not just how many people attend, it's **who we reach, and the impact we have on their lives.**

Together, we can help power a more connected and inclusive future.



# driving measurable outcomes

Midsumma engage with our audiences, and measurably improve wellbeing.

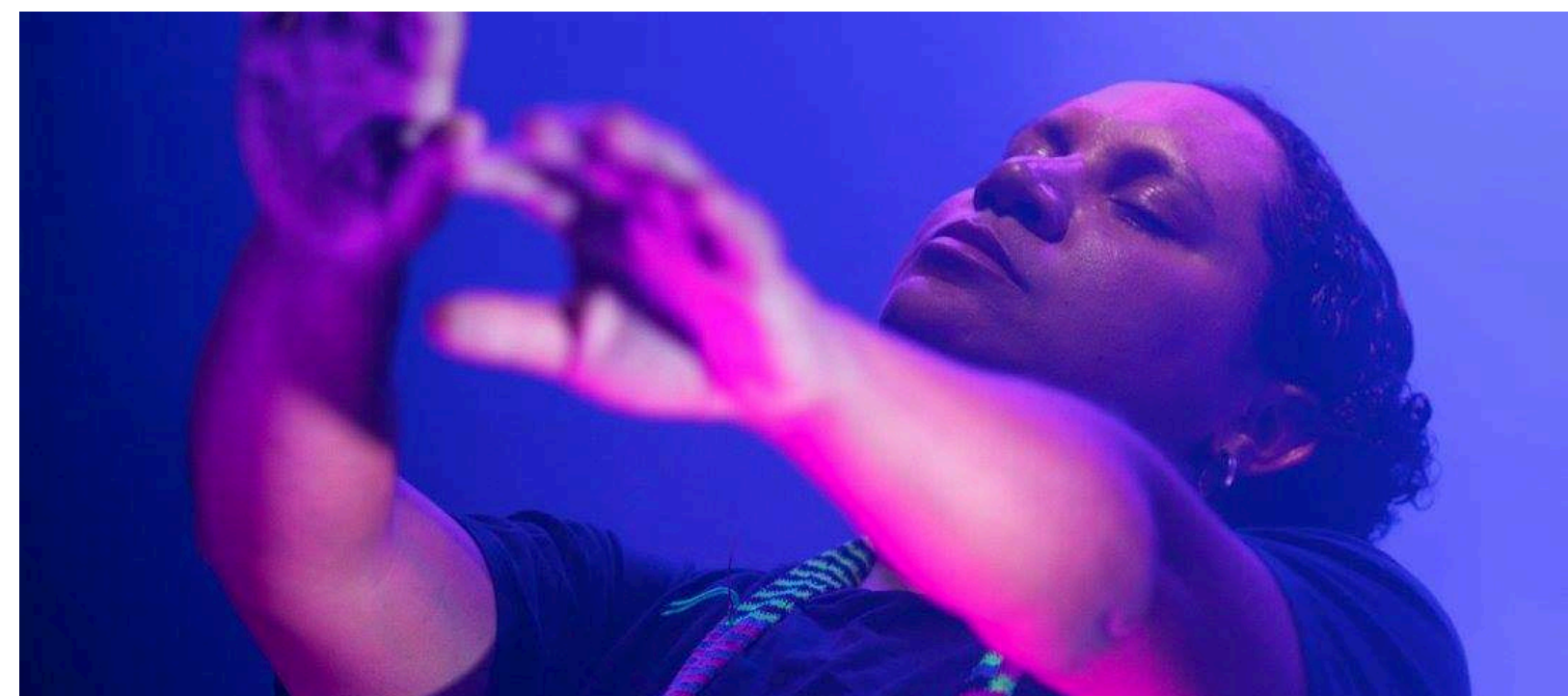
Independent research shows:

- 84% of attendees reported a **direct positive impact** on their personal wellbeing
- 92% felt **more connected** to community
- 96% felt **safe and welcome**
- 93% believe the festival creates ongoing **positive local impact**

These outcomes reflect the role Midsumma plays in:

- Reducing social isolation
- Creating safe, affirming environments
- **Supporting mental health through connection, identity, and expression**

# year-round community coverage

Beyond the festival, Midsumma invests in long-term community strength through:

- Mentorship and development programs for **emerging LGBTQIA+ artists**
- Dedicated pathways and commissioning for **artists with disability**
- **Regional programming** that expands access and representation across Victoria
- **Platforms for underrepresented voices**, including First Nations artists, queer artists of colour, and creatives with disability

This sustained engagement ensures impact is not momentary, but ongoing.

During the annual three-week festival, this work comes to life across 222 events in over 150 venues, creating visible, shared experiences of inclusion and connection.

Audience behaviour ([2026 Culture Counts Report](#)) reflects deep engagement:

- Attendees went to an average of **2.9 events each**
- **35%** attended 3–5 events, with many attending more
- **29% were first-time attendees**, showing continued growth and reach

Repeat, meaningful engagement at scale.

# the communities we support

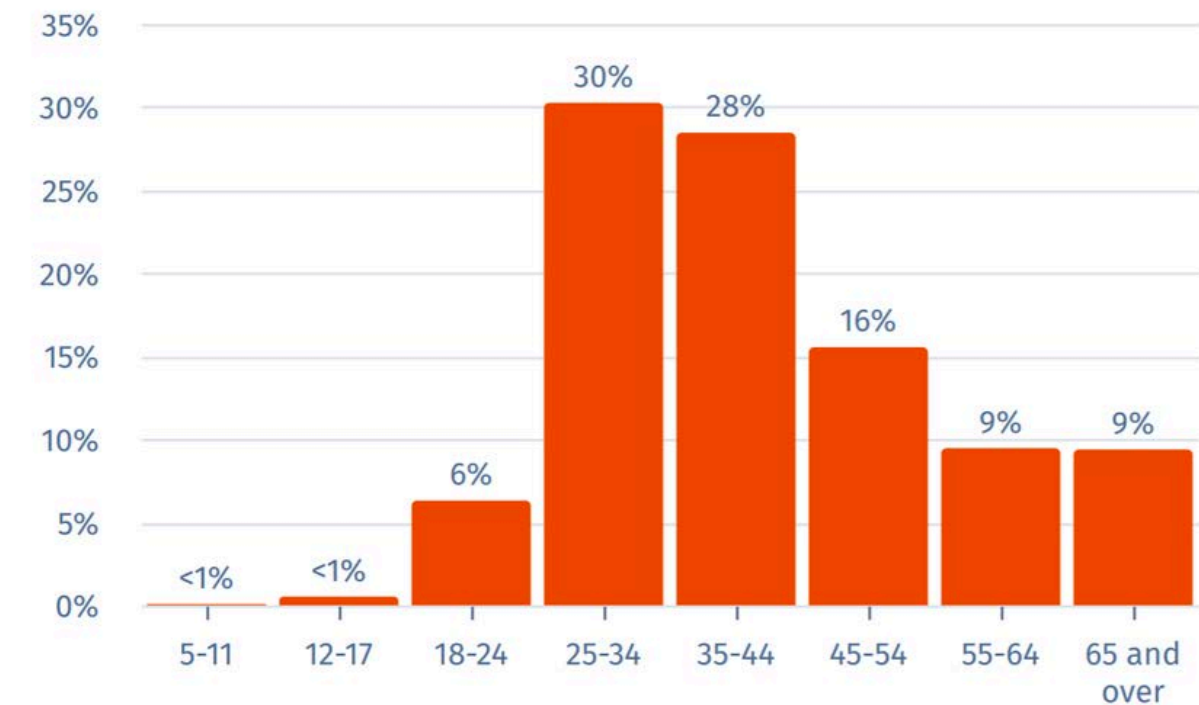
The diversity of our communities is what makes Midsumma so powerful - reflecting a broad, intersectional audience across life stages, identities, and lived experiences.

- 54% of attendees are **couples and families**
- Of those attending **with children**, 49% have children aged 4 and under, and 38% aged 5–11
- **25% identify as neurodiverse**
- 19% identify as culturally diverse or people of colour (CALD/PoC)
- Over 50% identify as **living with disability**

This breadth of representation is what positions Midsumma as one of Australia's most inclusive and community-driven cultural platforms, creating space for people to feel seen, supported, and connected.

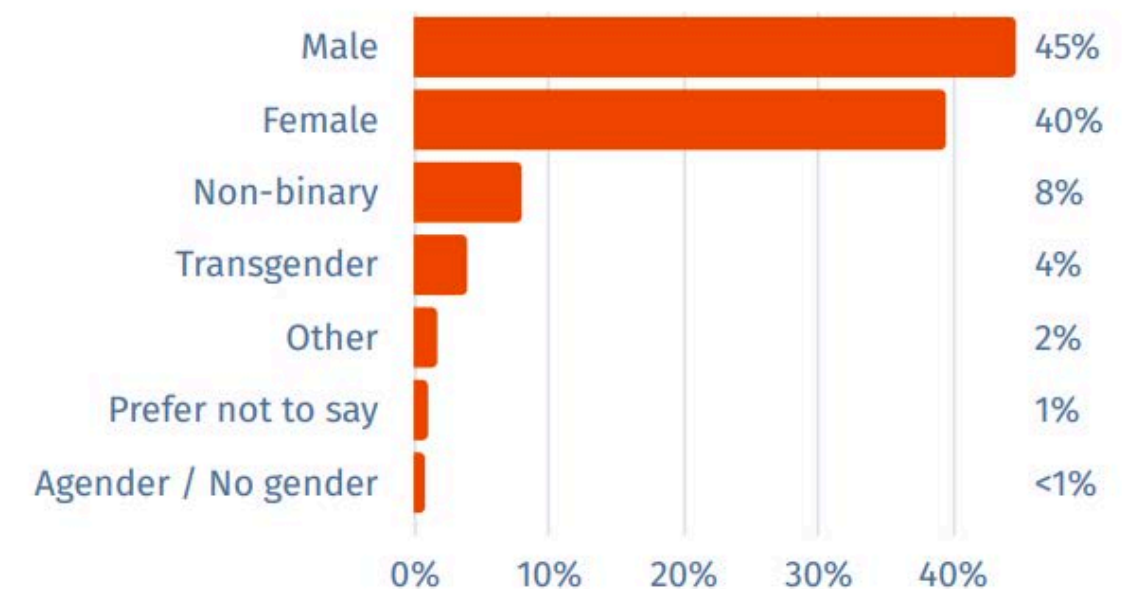
## Age Group

## arts & cultural participation partnership 2027

### The Midsumma (and AGL) Art Award

**\$30K p.a.**

**-Exclusive Naming Rights + National PR Recognition**

Australia's leading queer art award and a flagship cultural platform within the festival.

A nationally recognised visual arts award offering exclusive naming rights - positioning AGL at the forefront of contemporary queer arts and artist development in Australia.

Supporting leading and emerging LGBTQIA+ artists from across the country to create and exhibit bold, thought-provoking work across mediums. Finalists are selected nationally, making the award a true reflection of the breadth and diversity of queer artistic and cultural practice today.

### Queer Playwrights Award — \$15K p.a.

In partnership with Gasworks Arts Park, supporting the development of new LGBTQIA+ theatre and storytelling nationally. The mentorship program brings new queer narratives to mainstream stages. The winner of QPA will present their full stage production in Midsumma 2028 (Midsumma's 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary festival). **Outcome:** Positions AGL as a supporter of emerging playwrights, their voices and cultural storytelling.

### Homophon!c — \$10K p.a.

A national platform for emerging queer musicians and composers to develop and present original classical works. This one-of-a-kind award supports early-career artists and new creative queer expressions. **Outcome:** Alignment with bold new queer artists shaping the future of contemporary music.

## Midsumma Festival 2026 results:

- 334,531 total attendances – 9.9% increase on 2025
- 5.7M+ social media views, up from approximately 1.9M in 2025
- 544,801 social media reach, up 63.3%

- eNews performance above industry ave (39.9% OR, 2.3% CTR)
- Outdoor campaign delivered 118% of booked inventory
- 253,000 website users, including 198,858 new users (78.6%)
- 2.6M website interactions, indicating increased engagement depth
