Vehicle Marshal Brief Sheet

General Brief

- The march runs from 11am to approx. 1.30pm, with the Post Pride Celebrations running until 4pm.
- March Vehicles will arrive from 9am and marching groups will begin marshalling on Ian Johnson Oval from 9am.
- During your shift, direct vehicles when they arrive into the muster area (Lakeside Drive. Line them up in parade order, under the direction from the Vehicle Manager.
- Check driver and vehicle details against the approved list.
- Help Victorian Police in organising breath tests of all drivers.
- On direction from the Vehicle Manager, organise vehicles to enter the parade train at the right time.

This Role Suits

- Walking along the route from Ian Johnson Oval, down Fitzroy St to Catani Gardens is required.
- Using a 2way radio is required.
- Being organised, being able to respond quickly to directions and information and having clear communications skills are highly valuable.

On Arrival

- Go to Volunteer Headquarters at St Kilda Sports Club next to Ian Johnson Oval to sign on, and collect your accreditation and meal ticket.
- Meet up with Volunteer Coordinator at Volunteer HQ, then report to the Vehicle Marshal Manager (Siobhan) who will brief you on your role.

Sensitivity

- Many people who attend, volunteer or perform at Pride March represent diverse communities which may be at risk or prone to discrimination. Keep watch for antisocial crowd members and call for assistance through the EOC or security if required.
- Use gender-neutral pronouns until the person identifies their pronouns.

At the End of your Shift

- Please head to the Volunteer Tent at Catani Gardens and sign out.
- You are then free to enjoy the Post Pride Celebrations Event. Please change out of your volunteer t-shirt and accreditation at this time.
