- For the second year we are having the Midsumma Merchandise Tent.
- Midsumma survives on donations, but in recent times we know how hard it has been for everyone to donate so instead we're opening our merchandise store.
- On event day, Midsumma will be offering a collection of PRIDE accessories, branded merch, and sale of artworks.
- The online shop (Midsumma Closet) is also open.
- Midsumma is a non-profit organisation. 100% of profit and funds raised go directly back to artist and community development, access initiatives year-round, and our three-week Festival.

- Someone who enjoys one-on-one interactions and customer service.
- Organisational skills are valuable as well as FOH and retail experience.
- Seating available.
- Use of iPads is required.

On Arrival
